2. Conditions for Knowing God's Will

- 1. Commit to **obeying God's will** as He reveals it (Rom. 12:1)
- 2. **Turn from the world's ways** and allow God to transform us (Rom. 12:2).

 6. Special supernatural guidance or call (the exception) – Acts 10
