# CCID INTENTIONAL DEFINED

---

- **Intentional CCD** could be referred to as **purposefully** connecting with **people**, teaching them the **Word of God**, helping them grow in spiritual **disciplines** including **Prayer** and **exercising of Faith**, by the power of the **Holy Spirit**, and leading them into a deeper relationship with **Jesus Christ**. (*Matt. 4:18&19*)
